Karol Józef Wojtyła - Jan Paweł II

Karol Józef Wojtyła, known as John Paul II since his October 1978 election to the papacy, was born in the Polish town of Wadowice, a small city 50 kilometers from Krakow, on May 18, 1920. He was the young-



est of three children born to Karol Wojtyła and Emilia Kaczorowska. His mother died in 1929. His eldest brother Edmund, a doctor, died in 1932 and his father, a non-commissioned army officer died in 1941. A sister, Olga, had died before he was born.

"I lost my mother before the First Communion at the age of 9 and therefore I remember her less and I am less aware of her contribution to my religious education, and it was certainly very large."

"The father was a military man by profession, and when he widowed his life became even more a life of constant prayer. Sometimes I happened to wake up at night, and then I found my Father on his knees, just as I always saw him on his knees in the parish church."

"My brother Edmund worked in a hospital in Bielsko. I know he was very dedicated to the hospital and he took his work among the sick very seriously. His premature departure was deeply marked in my heart. Seventy years after his death, I still remember him with fraternal love and entrust his soul to merciful God."

He was baptized on June 20, 1920 in the parish church of Wadowice by Fr. Franciszek Zak. He received his First Holy Communion at age 9 and was confirmed at 18.

"When I look back, I see how the path of my life through the local environment, through the parish, through my family, leads me to one place, to the baptismal font in my parish church in Wadowice. By this baptismal font, I was accepted into the grace of God's sonship and faith of my Redeemer, to the community of His Church on June 20, 1920. I kissed solemnly this baptismal font once as, at that time the Archbishop of Kraków in the year of the millennium of the Baptism of Poland. Later. I did it for the second time, as the Prelate recalled, on the 50th anniversary of my baptism as a cardinal, and today, for the third time, I kissed this baptismal font, coming from



Rome as the successor of St. Peter." Upon graduation from Marcin Wadowita High School in Wadowice, he enrolled in Krakow's Jagiellonian University in 1938 and in a school for drama.

The Nazi occupation forces closed the university in 1939 and young Karol had to work in a quarry (1940-1944) and then in the Solvay chemical factory to earn his living and to avoid being deported to Germany. In 1942, aware of his call to the priesthood, he began courses in the clandestine seminary of Krakow, run by Cardinal Adam Stefan Sapieha, archbishop of Krakow. At the same time, Karol Wojtyła was one of the pioneers of the "Rhapsodic Theatre."

After the Second World War, he continued his studies in the major seminary of Krakow, once it had reopened, and in the faculty of theology of the Jagiellonian University. He was ordained to the priesthood by Archbishop Sapieha in Krakow on November 1, 1946.

Shortly afterwards, Cardinal Sapieha sent him to Rome where he worked under the guidance of the French Dominican, Garrigou-Lagrange. He finished his doctorate in theology in 1948 with a thesis on the subject of faith in the works of St. John of the Cross (Doctrina de fide apud Sanctum Ioannem a Cruce). At that time, during his vacations, he exercised his pastoral ministry among the Polish immigrants of France, Belgium, and Holland. In 1948, he returned to Poland and was vicar of various parishes in Krakow as well as chaplain to university students. This period lasted until 1951 when he again took up his studies in philosophy and theology. In 1953, he defended a thesis on "evaluation of the possibility of founding a Catholic ethic on the ethical system of Max Scheler" at Lublin Catholic University. Later he became professor of moral theology and social ethics in the major seminary of Krakow and in the Faculty of Theology of Lublin.

On July 4, 1958, he was appointed titular bishop of Ombi and auxiliary of Krakow by Pope Pius XII, and was consecrated September 28, 1958, in Wawel Cathedral, Krakow, by Archbishop Eugeniusz Baziak.

On January 13, 1964, he was appointed Archbishop of Krakow by Pope Paul VI, who made him a cardinal on June 26, 1967 with the title of S. Cesareo in Palatio of the order of deacons, later elevated pro illa vice to the order of priests.

Besides taking part in Vatican Council II (1962-1965) where he made an important contribution in drafting the Constitution Gaudium et spes, Cardinal Wojtyła participated in all the assemblies of the Synod of Bishops.

The Cardinals elected him Pope at the Conclave of 16 October 1978, and he took the name of John Paul II. On 22 October, the Lord's Day, he solemnly inaugurated his Petrine ministry as the 263rd successor to the Apostle. His pontificate, one of the longest in the history of the Church, lasted nearly 27 years.

Driven by his pastoral solicitude for all Churches and by a sense of openness and charity to the entire human race, John Paul II exercised the Petrine ministry with a tireless missionary spirit, dedicating it all his energy. He made 104 pastoral visits outside Italy and 146 within Italy. As bishop of Rome he visited 317 of the city's 333 parishes.

He had more meetings than any of his predecessors with the People of God and the leaders of Nations. More than 17,600,000 pilgrims participated in the General Audiences held on Wednesdays (more than 1160), not counting other special audiences and religious ceremonies [more than 8 million pilgrims during the Great Jubilee of the Year 2000 alone], and the millions of faithful he met during pastoral visits in Italy and throughout the world. We must also remember the numerous government personalities he encountered during 38 official visits, 738 audiences and meetings held with Heads of State, and 246 audiences and meetings with Prime Ministers. His love for young people brought him to establish the World Youth Days. The 19 WYDs celebrated during his pontificate brought together millions of young people from all over the world. At the same time his care for the family was expressed in the World Meetings of Families, which he initiated in 1994.

John Paul II successfully encouraged dialogue with the Jews and with the representatives of other religions, whom he several times invited to prayer meetings for







peace, especially in Assisi.

Under his guidance the Church prepared herself for the third millennium and celebrated the Great Jubilee of the year 2000 in accordance with the instructions given in the Apostolic Letter Tertio Millennio adveniente. The Church then faced the new epoch, receiving his instructions in the Apostolic Letter Novo Millennio ineunte, in which he indicated to the faithful their future path.

With the Year of the Redemption, the Marian Year and the Year of the Eucharist, he promoted the spiritual renewal of the Church.

He gave an extraordinary impetus to Canonizations and Beatifications, focusing on countless examples of holiness as an incentive for the people of our time. He celebrated 147 beatification ceremonies during which he proclaimed 1,338 Blessed; and 51 canonizations for a total of 482 Saints. He made Thérèse of the Child Jesus a Doctor of the Church.

He considerably expanded the College of Cardinals, creating 231 Cardinals (plus one in pectore) in 9 consistories. He also called six full meetings of the College of Cardinals.

He organized 15 Assemblies of the Synod of Bishops – six Ordinary General Assemblies, one Extraordinary General Assembly and eight Special Assemblies. On October 16, 1981, he established the John Paul II Foundation, which with great commitment fulfills the goals that the Founder himself established.

His most important Documents include 14 Encyclicals, 15 Apostolic Exhortations, 11 Apostolic Constitutions, 45 Apostolic Letters.

He promulgated the Catechism of the Catholic Church in the light of Tradition as authoritatively interpreted by the Second Vatican Council. He also reformed the Eastern and Western Codes of Canon Law, created new Institutions and reorganized the Roman Curia.

He also published five books of his own: "Crossing the Threshold of Hope" (October 1994), "Gift and Mystery, on the fiftieth anniversary of my ordination as priest" (November 1996), "Roman Triptych" poetic meditations (March 2003), "Rise, Let us Be on Our Way" (May 2004) and "Memory and Identity" (February 2005).

In the light of Christ risen from the dead, on 2 April A.D. 2005, at 9.37 p.m., while Saturday was drawing to a close and the Lord's Day was already beginning, the Octave of Easter and Divine Mercy Sunday, the Church's beloved Pastor, John Paul II, departed this world for the Father.

From that evening until April 8, the date of the funeral of the late Pontiff, more than three million pilgrims came to Rome to pay homage to the mortal remains of the Pope. Some of them queued up to 24 hours to enter St. Peter's Basilica.

On April 28, the Holy Father Benedict XVI announced that the normal five-year waiting period before beginning the cause of beatification and canonization would be waived for John Paul II. The cause was officially opened by Cardinal Camillo Ruini, vicar general for the diocese of Rome, on June 28 2005.

The beatification ceremony of John Paul II took place on May 1, 2011, on the Divine Mercy Sunday. The Beatification Mass at the Vatican was celebrated by several thousand Cardinals, Archbishops and Bishops from all over the world. It was attended by one and a half million faithful.

On September 30, 2013, during the consistory, Pope Francis announced that John XXIII would be declared Saint along with John Paul II. On April 27, 2014, on the Divine Mercy Sunday, John Paul II was proclaimed a saint.

In the historic ceremony on the St. Peter's Square in Rome more than 800,000 pilgrims from all over the world participated in it.

"We declare and define Blessed John XXIII and John Paul II to be saints and we enroll them among the saints, decreeing that they are to be venerated as such by the whole church. In the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit."- Pope Francis.

Also, we would like to encourage to celebrate the birth anniversary of St. John Paul II in our Chapters, parishes, and dioceses and we are already inviting you to join us in our celebrations next year in Rome.

Let St. John Paul II, Patron of our Foundation, through His intercession with God, implore the necessary graces and bring help in these difficult times.

Triptych in the Polish cath. mission in Rosenheim (24 X – 8 XI, 2019)

The Polish Catholic Mission in Rosenheim was the third parish in the Southern Deanery (after Munich and Ingolstadt) of the Polish Pastoral service in Germany, which was visited by the Triptych depicting Our Lady of Częstochowa, Saint Faustyna Kowalska and St. John Paul II along with the relics of the Holy Father. The visitation of the Triptych which relate to the 100th anniversary of the birth of Karol Wojtyła that took place this year, gathered the faithful at the Masses, which always ended with the veneration of the relic of St. John Paul II.

The Triptych was placed in the chapel in the Center of the Polish Mission, which is also used by the faithful of the Croatian Mission, who were very happy that they were able to pray in front of the Triptych and relic.

On Friday, November 8th, after the Holy Mass we had to bid farewell. We prayed the Chaplet to the Divine Mercy, a prayer for the St. John Paul II intercession to God to grant us necessary graces. Then, we sang "Barge" and Jasna Góra Novena and venerated the relic of the Holy Father. In such manner we ended this good time of the visitation.

During the visitation, the faithful people had the opportunity to deepen their faith and strengthen the bonds which they have, through Our Lady of Częstochowa and the Polish Saints, with their Homeland and the Catholic Church.





Passing of the triptych and relics of St. John Paul II from the USA to Canada

Triptych with relics of St. John Paul II peregrinates in various parishes in the USA since August 15, 2019. The initiative of the triptych and relics' visitation is related to the 100th anniversary of the birth of Karol Wojtyła. On January 7, 2020, Pauline Fathers from Buffalo (USA) passed the Triptych along with the relics of St. John Paul II to priests who are working in Mississauga (Canada). Fr. Janusz Błażejak, pastor from the St. Maximillian Church and Fr. Adam Wróblewicz CR, pastor from the St. Joseph Church in Brantford welcomed the triptych and relics.

Fr. Adam Wróblewicz CR was named the curator of the triptych in Canada. During the welcome, he expressed special gratitude for this great gift of the triptych visitation and presented an initial program of visitation. In his parish, the visitation will take place from March 14 to March 20. "The peregrination time will coincide with the feast of St. Joseph, patron of Canada and our parish – says Fr. Adam Wróblewicz CR. We thank God for this great gift of the Holy Pope, and at the same time we want to prepare in the best possible manner for this great celebration of the 100th anniversary. May 18, 2020 marks the 100th anniversary of the birth of St. Pope John Paul II. The 6th Ann of the John Paul II Canonization

Six years ago, on April 27, 2014, two popes were canonized -John Paul II and John XXIII. The ceremony took place on the Divine Mercy Sunday, a feast established by the Polish Pope. In a historic ceremony on the St. Peter's Square in Rome, more than 800,000 pilgrims from all over the world participated in it. It was an event without precedent - at the same time two Popes were named as saints. In addition, for the first time ever, two Popes – current Pope Francis and among Cardinals - retired Pope Benedict XVI celebrated the canonization mass. Pope Francis announced new saints.

"We declare and define Blessed John XXIII and John Paul II to be saints and we enroll them among the saints, decreeing that they are to be venerated as such by the whole church. In the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit."- he said. In his homily, Pope Francis emphasized that both canonized "were not ashamed of the flesh of Christ, they were not scandalized by Him, by His cross." Having in mind that all public celebrations related to the 6th anniversary of the canonization of John Paul II were cancelled in Italy, on Monday April 27, 2020 at 7:00 a.m. in the St. Peter's Basilica at the relics of St. John Paul II, a holy Mass will be celebrated by Cardinal Konrad Krajewski. We ask all members and benefactors of the John Paul II Foundation for spiritual communion and joint prayer on this day at 7:00 a.m. roman time asking the merciful God to stop the coronavirus pandemic in the world.


