

DAY 2 - SEPTEMBER 22, 2022

Holy Mass at the Sanctuary of Our Lady "Ad Rupes" - Castel Sant 'Elia celebrated by Archbishop Józef Staniewski and the homily was delivered by the Chairman of the Administrative Council Monsignor Paweł Ptasznik

"Saints do not die. Saints call us for holiness " - these words were said by John Paul II in 1999 in Stary Sacz, referring them to St. Kinga. It probably didn't even occur to him that one day those words would apply to him. Yes, just today, when we celebrate the 40th anniversary of the Foundation bearing the name of St. John Paul II, we joyfully apply these words to him. He did not pass away, he remained among us. He is present in our memories, in past and present emotions, in our prayers. There is among us - the great saint of our time; he is here and he is calling - he is calling us for holiness. So let us get closer to him, let us try to penetrate the mystery of his holiness in order

to draw from it and to learn from it.

1. Christ's love.

"Do not be afraid! Open, open wide the doors to Christ! (...) Christ knows "what is in a person". Only He knows it! (...) So, let - I am begging you, I am begging you with humility and trust - let Christ speak to man. He alone has the words of life, yes, eternal life. " We remember this invitation that John Paul II addressed to the faithful and people of good will all over the world in his speech during the Holy Mass at the beginning of his pontificate. This cry came from the bottom of his heart, from his unwavering conviction, from the certainty of faith.

2. Love for man

Love for Christ, which is manifested in listening to God's word, in prayer and sacraments, was the foundation of John Paul II's holiness. However, whoever truly feels loved by Christ and reciprocates this love quickly learns that it is not only "for his own use", but that it grows, deepens, and bears fruit only when it is shared with others. Thus, in the life of John Paul II, the love of Christ was reflected and realized in love for man.

Sisters and brothers, let us entrust our faith path, our daily life and our hopes to the intercession of St. John Paul II. May he inspire us and lead us to meet Christ, who lives and reigns now and forever! Amen.





















DAY 3 - SEPTEMBER 23, 2022

Symposium on John Paul II at the Urbaniana University





First of all, I would like to thank and express appreciation for organizing today's Symposium in the context of the fortieth anniversary of the establishment of the John Paul II Foundation. As the organizers of the Symposium rightly decided, its purpose was not and is not simply to summarize the Foundation's achievements, but to reflect on its current condition and activities, and to collect new thoughts and proposals for the development of the program for the future.

The Foundation was established at a specific historical moment, in the first years of the pontificate, which turned

out to be one of the longest in the history of the Church. The Pope who came to Rome "from a far country" faced the great challenges of the era. Among these challenges was the persisting, though shaky, totalitarian communist system that enslaved the countries of Central and Eastern Europe. The Foundation wanted to accompany John Paul II, support and document his pontificate, guided by the right intuition that the next generations will be able to draw from this heritage, not only in the Pope's Homeland.

After forty years since its foundation, the world and the Church have

changed. John Paul II passed away to eternity seventeen years ago. His beatification and canonization - and this shortly after his departure to the Father's house - were the seal of the authenticity of his holiness, spirituality and teaching. This fact illuminated and justified the foundations and goals of the Foundation even more. (...)

The outline of the universalism and missionary nature of the Church is part of the spiritual heritage handed over to us by the Holy Pope, the Patron of the Foundation. We want to live this heritage and pass it to the next generation. " S. Card. Dziwisz









Holy Mass in the Basilica of St. John Lateran under the leadership of Archbishop Marek Jędraszewski

Homily delivered by Archbishop Marek Jędraszewski on the occasion of the 40th anniversary of the John Paul II Foundation on September 23, during the Holy Mass in St. John in Lateran in Rome.

If the time of the Church is an open time, then also the time of St. John Paul II the Great's ministry had to be an open time. And, so it was throughout the years of his long pontificate. He himself constantly looked to the future and taught this forward-looking way to the entire Church. Faced with the guestion of the correct way to live this particular time of the Church's Advent in the face of the approaching end of the second and third millennium of its history, the Holy Father answered in the Encyclical Redemptor Hominis, published in 1979: "To this question, dear Brothers, sons, and daughters, a fundamental and essential response must be given. Our response must be: Our spirit is set in one direction, the only direction for our intellect, will and heart is-towards Christ our Redeemer, towards Christ, the Redeemer of man. We wish to look towards him-because there is salvation in no one else but him, the Son of God-repeating what Peter said: "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life."

On January 6, 2001, as the third Christian millennium began, St. John Paul II published the Apostolic Letter Novo Millennio Ineunte, in which he included the following message for the future: ""Let us go forward in hope! A new millennium is opening before the Church like a vast ocean upon which we shall venture, relying on the help of Christ. The Son of God, who became incarnate two thousand years ago out of love for humanity, is at work even today: we need discerning eyes to see this and, above all, a generous heart to become the instruments of his work. (...) At the beginning of this new century, our steps must quicken as we travel the highways of the world. Many are the paths on which each one of us and each of our Churches must travel, but there is no distance between those who are united in the same communion, the communion which is daily nourished at the table of the Eucharistic Bread and the Word of Life. (...) On this journey we are accompanied by the Blessed Virgin Mary to whom, (...) I entrusted the Third Millennium. During this year

I have often invoked her as the "Star of the New Evangelization". Now, I point to Mary once again as the radiant dawn and sure guide for our steps. At the beginning of this new century, our steps must quicken as we travel the highways of the world. (NMI, 58).

In this open time of the entire Church, St. John Paul II also inscribed his personal time. This became more and more evident as the end of his earthly pilgrimage approached.

His forward-looking – his open time was always rooted. Referring to his poem 'Thinking Homeland'... from 1974, we can say: constantly, fully consciously, he emerged from his beloved Poland and, at the same time, he constantly was putting roots in it. He understood it as a treasure, constantly asking: "how to multiply it, how to expand this space that it fills". The Foundation of St. John Paul II, in which, by the will of Divine Providence, we were given the opportunity to work, is not only to consolidate our memory of him, but also to deepen: for our good, for the proper formation of our identity, so that our lives and those who will come after us may be filled with hope, a time that is open to eternity.















DAY 4 - SEPTEMBER 24, 2022

Holy Mass in the Shrine of St. Rita – Cascia said by Archbishop Józef Staniewski

On the fourth day of the Jubilee celebrations of the John Paul II Foundation, we meet at the sanctuary St. Rita about which John Paul II himself said: When we ask St. Rita for the secret of her extraordinary work of social and moral renewal, we answer: fidelity to the Love who was crucified. Rita, together with Christ and like Christ, approaches the cross always and only through love. And, we like her, lift our eyes and hearts to Jesus, who died on the cross and rose for our salvation. It is he, our Redeemer, who makes the mission of unity and fidelity proper to the family possible, as in the case of this beloved saint, even in times of crisis and difficulty.

He is the one who gives concrete shape to the Christian commitment to building peace, helping families overcome the conflicts and tensions that unfortunately are so frequent in everyday life."

"O Saint Rita, before your altar, we humbly bow our heads,

when in difficult moments of our lives we ask for your help.

Ask the Lord for us the power of the spirit of Hope and Love"

These words of a song specially composed in honor of St. Rita, we invoke again because we and the whole world need rays of hope and the warmth of love. As St. John Paul II said: hope is needed - against hope.

Saint Rita of Cascia was a wife, mother, widow, and member of a religious community. Her holiness was reflected in each phase of her life. Born at Roccaporena in central Italy, Rita wanted to become a nun but was pressured at a young age into marrying a harsh and cruel man. During her 18-year marriage, she bore and raised two sons. After her husband was killed in a brawl and her sons had died, Rita tried to join the Augustinian nuns in Cascia. When she developed wounds on her forehead, people quickly associated them with the wounds from Christ's crown of thorns. She meditated frequently on Christ's passion. She was beatified in 1626 and canonized 1900.



Today we thank God for the providential decision which was taken years ago to create the Papal Foundation. It produced a lot of good frits and of various kinds. thers and sisters, as we thank Almighty God, the Lord of human history, today for the Foundation's activities, let us ask that it continue to bear fruit of goodness and love, which has many names. Let us entrust to God the deceased members and benefactors of the Foundation, that the King of the kings and the Lord of the rulers may take them into His kingdom of love and peace. Let us ask for peace in the tormented land of Ukraine and wherever man raises his hand on man. Let us ask for our homeland - Poland - not to cease to be semper fidelis – always faithful to Christ and His Church and to the Successor of St. Peter.
