TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE SCIENTIFIC COMPETITION FOR STUDENTS

as part of Saint John Paul II Days at Pontifical Universities of Rome in 2024

- 1. The competition is an integral part of the initiative of the Saint John Paul II Days at Pontifical Universities of Rome and is conducted by its organizers, who are: John Paul II Vatican Foundation, St. Stanislaus B&M Church in Rome and the Pontifical University of John Paul II in Krakow.
- 2. Only students of the 1st, 2nd or 3rd cycle of studies at the Pontifical Universities in Rome may participate in the competition.
- 3. The competition consists of preparing and submitting to the organizers a scientific article on a topic related to the theme of the year.
- 4. The theme of the Days in 2024 is: "Faith and reason in the thought of St. John Paul II".
- 5. Scientific articles must be written in Italian or English.
- 6. The maximum volume of the article is 35,000 characters with spaces.
- 7. The papers should be sent to the e-mail address: concorso@fjp2.com on or before November 10, 2024.
- 8. The committee evaluating the submitted works includes professors of the universities co-organizing the event, and its decisions are not subject to appeal.
- 9. The three best works will be presented by the authors at the gala event concluding the Days celebration and proposed for publication in selected scientific journals.
- 10. The speeches of the awarded authors at the gala may take the form of both a classic reading and a multimedia presentation, must not exceed 20 minutes and must be in Italian or English.
- 11. The authors of the three best works will receive cash prizes (€2,000 for 1st place, €1,500 for 2nd place and €1,000 for 3rd place) and will be awarded a five-day trip to Poland in April 2025.
